4	A BILL to amend and reenact § 22.1-253.13:7 of the Code of Virginia, relating to school boards; school
5	libraries; contents; online portal for parents.

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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 22.1-253.13:7 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-253.13:7. Standard 7. School board policies.
13	A. Each local school board shall develop policies and procedures to address complaints of sexual
14 15	abuse of a student by a teacher or other school board employee. B. Each local school board shall maintain and follow up-to-date policies. All school board policies
16	shall be reviewed at least every five years and revised as needed.
17	C. Each local school board shall ensure that policies are developed <i>and adopted</i> giving consideration
18	to the views of teachers, parents, and other concerned citizens and addressing or including the following:
19	1. A system of two-way communication between employees and the local school board and its
20	administrative staff whereby matters of concern can be discussed in an orderly and constructive manner;
21	2. The selection and evaluation of all instructional materials purchased by the school division, with
22 23	clear procedures for handling challenged controversial materials; 3. The standards of student conduct and attendance and enforcement procedures designed to provide
23 24	that public education be conducted in an atmosphere free of disruption and threat to persons or property
25	and supportive of individual rights;
26	4. School-community communications and community involvement;
27	5. Guidelines to encourage parents to provide instructional assistance to their children in the home,
28	which may include voluntary training for the parents of children in grades K through three;
29 30	6. Information about procedures for addressing concerns with the school division and recourse
30 31	available to parents pursuant to § 22.1-87; 7. A cooperatively developed procedure for personnel evaluation appropriate to tasks performed by
32	those being evaluated; and
33	8. Grievances, dismissals, etc., of teachers, and the implementation procedure prescribed by the
34	General Assembly and the Board of Education, as provided in Article 3 (§ 22.1-306 et seq.) of Chapter
35	15, and the maintenance of copies of such procedures; and
36	9. A requirement for the school board to (i) develop and maintain an online portal that is accessible
37 38	by the parent of each student enrolled in the local school division whereby the parent may access a detailed description of the content of and other relevant information about each book contained in the
	library of the school that his child attends and (ii) email to the parent of a student enrolled in the local
40	school division whenever such student checks a book out of the school library (a) the name of the book
41	and (b) a link to the online portal required to be maintained pursuant to this subdivision.
42	D. A current copy of all school division policies and regulations approved by the local school board,
43	including the Student Conduct Policy, shall be posted on the division's website and shall be available to
44 45	employees and to the public. School boards shall ensure that printed copies of such policies and regulations are available as needed to citizens who do not have opling access.
45 46	regulations are available as needed to citizens who do not have online access. E. An annual announcement shall be made in each division at the beginning of the school year and,
47	for parents of students enrolling later in the academic year, at the time of enrollment, advising the public
48	that the policies are available in such places.
