2 *An Act to amend the Code of Virginia by adding a section numbered 54.1-2409.1:1, relating to*  
3 *interjurisdictional compacts; criminal history record checks.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-2409.1:1 as follows:**8 ***§ 54.1-2409.1:1. Interjurisdictional compacts; criminal history record checks.***

9 *If an interjurisdictional compact requires criminal history record checks as a condition of*  
10 *participation, the applicable health regulatory board shall require each applicant to submit to*  
11 *fingerprinting and provide personal descriptive information to be forwarded along with his fingerprints*  
12 *through the Central Criminal Records Exchange to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purpose*  
13 *of obtaining criminal history record information. The cost of fingerprinting and the criminal history*  
14 *record search shall be paid by the applicant.*

15 *The Central Criminal Records Exchange shall forward the results of the state and federal criminal*  
16 *history record search to the applicable health regulatory board. If an applicant is denied licensure*  
17 *because of information appearing on his criminal history record and the applicant disputes the*  
18 *information upon which the denial was based, the Central Criminal Records Exchange shall, upon*  
19 *written request, furnish to the applicant the procedures for obtaining a copy of the criminal history*  
20 *record from the Federal Bureau of Investigation and the Central Criminal Records Exchange.*  
21 *Information obtained pursuant to this section shall not be disseminated except as provided in this*  
22 *section.*
