234567 A BILL to direct the Secretary of Health and Human Resources to convene a work group to analyze and review current reimbursement and operational challenges for medical practices that administer 8 anti-cancer drugs in an in-office setting; report.

9 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

10 1. § 1. That the Secretary of Health and Human Resources (the Secretary), in collaboration with the 11 Department of Health, shall convene a work group to analyze and review current reimbursement and operational challenges for medical practices that administer anti-cancer drugs in an in-office setting to 12 patients whose costs for such treatment are paid for by Medicare, Medicaid, or TRICARE. The analysis 13 14 shall consider the impact on and accessibility of such treatment for Medicaid, Medicare, and TRICARE 15 patients. The work group shall include relevant stakeholders, including representatives from the Medical 16 Society of Virginia, the Virginia Association of Hematologists and Oncologists, the Virginia Association of Counties, and the Virginia Municipal League. Assistance shall be provided to the work group by the 17 Department of Medical Assistance Services. The work group shall complete its meetings by October 1, 18 2023, and submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Chairmen of the House Committee 19 20 on Finance, the House Committee on Appropriations, the House Committee on Health, Welfare and 21 Institutions, the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations, and the Senate Committee on 22 Education and Health by November 15, 2023.
