An Act to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-740, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.4, 46.2-743, 46.2-744, 46.2-746.1, 2 46.2-746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3, 46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of 3 4 the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates; military service; unremarried surviving 5 spouses.

8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

9 1. That §§ 46.2-740, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.4, 46.2-743, 46.2-744, 46.2-746.1, 46.2-746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3, 10 46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of the Code of Virginia are

amended and reenacted as follows: 11

§ 46.2-740. Special license plates for survivors of Battle of Chosin Reservoir.

13 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a survivor of the Battle of Chosin Reservoir, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the applicant. 14

15 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section. 16

17 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section may also be issued special license plates under this section. 18 19

§ 46.2-741. Special license plates for survivors of attack on Pearl Harbor; fees.

20 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged 21 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States and, while serving in the armed forces of the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, on 22 23 December 7, 1941, between the hours of 7:55 a.m. and 9:45 a.m., Hawaii time, the Commissioner shall 24 issue to the applicant special license plates identifying the vehicle as registered to a Pearl Harbor 25 survivor.

26 For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to 27 the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued.

28 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 29 plates issued under this section.

30 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 31 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 32

§ 46.2-742.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge.

33 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Combat 34 Infantryman Badge, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

35 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section may also be issued special license plates under this section. 36

37 § 46.2-743. Special license plates for active duty members of the armed forces of the United 38 States and certain veterans; fees.

39 A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged 40 former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the 41 applicant special license plates. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special 42 license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

43 B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the 44 45 United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of **46** 47 persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license 48 plates under this subsection.

49 C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 50 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design 51 incorporates an emblem of the United States Army. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to 52 53 receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this 54 subsection.

55 D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 56 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the

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57 United States Coast Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
58 design incorporates an emblem of the United States Coast Guard. Unremarried surviving spouses of
59 persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
60 plates under this subsection.

61 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 62 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the 63 United States Navy, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design 64 incorporates an emblem of the United States Navy. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to 65 receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this 66 subsection. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this subsection shall be \$25 in addition to the prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations 67 pursuant to this subsection, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special 68 nonreverting fund known as the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society Fund established within the 69 70 Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society and used to support its operation and programs in Virginia. All other fees imposed under the provisions 71 of this subsection shall be paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor 72 73 Vehicles and paid by him into the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the 74 necessary expenses incurred by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

F. All special license plates that have been developed and issued pursuant to subsection B, C, D, or
E shall also be issued to applicants who can provide documentation from the U.S. Department of
Veterans Affairs indicating that the applicant has been designated disabled, and that his disability is
service-connected, and that he has been honorably discharged from a branch of the armed forces of the
United States.

G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II,
the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license
plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of
state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. Unremarried surviving
spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued
special license plates under this subsection.

86 H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
87 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War. Unremarried
88 surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be
89 issued special license plates under this subsection.

90 I. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
91 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War. Unremarried
92 surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be
93 issued special license plates under this subsection.

J. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

K. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation Iraqi
 Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection
 may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

104 L. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
105 Enduring Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation
106 Enduring Freedom. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates
107 under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

M. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Virginia
 Defense Force, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Virginia Defense
 Force. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
 subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

N. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans
of those military operations. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license
plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

116 O. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued 117 under subsections G, H, J, K, L, M, and N.

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118 § 46.2-744. Special license plates for members of National Guard; fees.

119 On receipt of an application and written confirmation that the applicant is a member of the National 120 Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

No fee shall be charged for license plates issued under this section to a member of the Virginia 121 122 National Guard for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally by the applicant, unless the plates 123 bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, the fee for the 124 issuance of license plates shall be the same as for those issued under § 46.2-726. For each additional set 125 of license plates issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed 126 fee for state license plates.

127 The fee for members of non-Virginia National Guard units shall be ten dollars per year plus the 128 prescribed cost for state license plates, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for 129 in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, such license plates shall be subject to an additional charge of ten 130 dollars per year for the reserved numbers or letters.

131 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 132 plates issued under this section.

133 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 134 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 135

§ 46.2-746.1. Special license plates for members of military assault forces.

136 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been, while serving in 137 the armed forces of the United States, a member of a military assault force, the Commissioner shall 138 issue to the applicant special license plates. For the purposes of this section, a military assault force is a 139 unit or element of the armed forces of the United States engaged in or charged with the invasion or **140** capture of territory under the control of enemy forces.

141 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 142 plates issued under this section.

143 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 144 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

145 § 46.2-746.2:2. Special license plates; members and former members of the 173rd Airborne 146 Brigade.

147 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 148 member or former member of the 173rd Airborne Brigade, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant 149 special license plates.

150 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 151 plates issued under this section.

152 No license plates shall be issued under this section unless and until a one-time fee of \$3,500 shall 153 have been paid to the Commissioner.

154 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 155 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 156

§ 46.2-746.2:3. Members and former members of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard).

157 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 158 member or former member of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard), the Commissioner shall issue 159 special license plates to members and former members of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard).

160 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 161 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 162

§ 46.2-746.2:4. Members of the Special Forces Association; fee.

163 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 164 member of the Special Forces Association, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 165 plates.

The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under 166 167 this section.

168 No license plates provided for in this section shall be issued unless and until the Commissioner 169 receives at least 50 prepaid applications therefor and payment of a one-time fee of \$3,500, less the total 170 amount of \$10 annual fees collected from the prepaid applications received.

171 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 172 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

173 § 46.2-746.2:6. Special license plates; members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United 174 States organization.

175 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States organization, the Commissioner shall 176 177 issue special license plates to the applicant.

178 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section **179** may also be issued special license plates under this section.

180 § 46.2-746.3. Special license plates for members or veterans of certain military reserve 181 organizations.

182 The Commissioner, on application therefor, shall issue special license plates to members or veterans
183 of the Air Force Reserve, the Army Reserve, the Coast Guard Reserve, the Marine Reserve, and the
184 Naval Reserve. Such special license plates may, when feasible, bear decals or stickers identifying the

185 reserve organization of which the applicant is or was a member.

186 The provisions of subdivision \hat{B} 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.

188 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section189 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

190 § 46.2-746.5. Special license plates for National Guard retirees; fees.

191 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a retired member of the 192 National Guard, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to National Guard retirees.

193 No fee shall be charged for license plates issued under the provisions of this section to retired194 members of the Virginia National Guard.

195 The fee for non-Virginia National Guard retirees shall be \$10 per year plus the prescribed cost for 196 state license plates, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in § 46.2-726. In 197 this latter case, such license plates shall be subject to an additional charge of \$10 per year for the 198 reserved numbers or letters.

199 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section200 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

201 § 46.2-749.46. Special license plates; naval aviators.

202 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been a naval aviator,203 the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

204 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section
 205 may also be issued special license plates under this section.
