6	A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 46.2-740, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.4, 46.2-743, 46.2-744, 46.2-746.1,
7	46.2-746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3, 46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of
8	the Code of Virginia, relating to special license plates; military service; unremarried surviving
9	spouses.
10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11 12	1. That §§ 46.2-740, 46.2-741, 46.2-742.4, 46.2-743, 46.2-744, 46.2-746.1, 46.2-746.2:2, 46.2-746.2:3, 46.2-746.2:4, 46.2-746.2:6, 46.2-746.3, 46.2-746.5, and 46.2-749.46 of the Code of Virginia are
13	amended and reenacted as follows:
14	§ 46.2-740. Special license plates for survivors of Battle of Chosin Reservoir.
15	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a survivor of the Battle of
16	Chosin Reservoir, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to the applicant.
17 18	The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this section.
10 19	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section
20	may also be issued special license plates under this section.
21	§ 46.2-741. Special license plates for survivors of attack on Pearl Harbor; fees.
22	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
23 24	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States and, while serving in the armed forces of the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Osbu. Tarritory of Houseii on
24 25	of the United States, was present during the attack on the island of Oahu, Territory of Hawaii, on December 7, 1941, between the hours of 7:55 a.m. and 9:45 a.m., Hawaii time, the Commissioner shall
26	issue to the applicant special license plates identifying the vehicle as registered to a Pearl Harbor
27	survivor.
28	For each set of license plates issued under this section, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to
29 30	the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of ten dollars at the time the plates are issued. The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license
30 31	plates issued under this section.
32	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section
33	may also be issued special license plates under this section.
34 35	§ 46.2-742.4. Special license plates for persons awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge.
35 36	On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant has been awarded the Combat Infantryman Badge, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.
37	Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section
38	may also be issued special license plates under this section.
39	§ 46.2-743. Special license plates for active duty members of the armed forces of the United
40 41	States and certain veterans; fees. A. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is an honorably discharged
42	former member of one of the armed forces of the United States, the Commissioner shall issue to the
43	applicant special license plates. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special
44	license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.
45	B. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
46 47	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United States Marine Corps, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose
4 7 48	design incorporates an emblem of the United States Marine Corps. Unremarried surviving spouses of
49	persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
50	plates under this subsection.
51	C. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
52 53	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United States Army, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design
55 54	incorporates an emblem of the United States Army. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to
55	receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this
56	subsection.
57 58	D. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has
58 59	been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the United States Coast Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose

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design incorporates an emblem of the United States Coast Guard. Unremarried surviving spouses of
 persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license
 plates under this subsection.

63 E. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is on active duty with, has 64 been honorably discharged after at least six months of active duty service in, or has retired from the 65 United States Navy, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates whose design 66 incorporates an emblem of the United States Navy. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this 67 subsection. The annual fee for plates issued pursuant to this subsection shall be \$25 in addition to the 68 69 prescribed fee for state license plates. For each such \$25 fee collected in excess of 1,000 registrations pursuant to this subsection, \$15 shall be paid into the state treasury and credited to a special nonreverting fund known as the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society Fund established within the 70 71 72 Department of Accounts. These funds shall be paid annually to the Navy-Marine Corps Relief Society and used to support its operation and programs in Virginia. All other fees imposed under the provisions 73 of this subsection shall be paid to, and received by, the Commissioner of the Department of Motor 74 Vehicles and paid by him into the state treasury and set aside as a special fund to be used to meet the 75 76 necessary expenses incurred by the Department of Motor Vehicles.

F. All special license plates that have been developed and issued pursuant to subsection B, C, D, or
E shall also be issued to applicants who can provide documentation from the U.S. Department of
Veterans Affairs indicating that the applicant has been designated disabled, and that his disability is
service-connected, and that he has been honorably discharged from a branch of the armed forces of the
United States.

G. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of World War II, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of World War II. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are issued. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

88 H. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Korean
89 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Korean War. Unremarried
90 surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be
91 issued special license plates under this subsection.

92 I. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the Vietnam
93 War, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of the Vietnam War. Unremarried
94 surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be
95 issued special license plates under this subsection.

J. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of the
Asiatic-Pacific Campaign, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of that
campaign. For each set of license plates issued under this subsection, the Commissioner shall charge, in
addition to the prescribed cost of state license plates, a one-time fee of \$10 at the time the plates are
issued. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

K. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation Iraqi
 Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation Iraqi Freedom.
 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

L. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
Enduring Freedom, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans of Operation
Enduring Freedom. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates
under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

M. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a member of the Virginia
Defense Force, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members of the Virginia Defense
Force. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this
subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

N. On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a veteran of Operation
Desert Shield or Operation Desert Storm, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to veterans
of those military operations. Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license
plates under this subsection may also be issued special license plates under this subsection.

118 O. The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and B 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued 119 under subsections G, H, J, K, L, M, and N.

120 § 46.2-744. Special license plates for members of National Guard; fees.

121 On receipt of an application and written confirmation that the applicant is a member of the National

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122 Guard, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

123 No fee shall be charged for license plates issued under this section to a member of the Virginia 124 National Guard for any one motor vehicle owned and used personally by the applicant, unless the plates 125 bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, the fee for the 126 issuance of license plates shall be the same as for those issued under § 46.2-726. For each additional set 127 of license plates issued to an applicant under this section, the Commissioner shall charge the prescribed 128 fee for state license plates.

129 The fee for members of non-Virginia National Guard units shall be ten dollars per year plus the 130 prescribed cost for state license plates, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for 131 in § 46.2-726. In this latter case, such license plates shall be subject to an additional charge of ten 132 dollars per year for the reserved numbers or letters.

133 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 134 plates issued under this section.

135 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 136 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 137

§ 46.2-746.1. Special license plates for members of military assault forces.

138 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been, while serving in 139 the armed forces of the United States, a member of a military assault force, the Commissioner shall 140 issue to the applicant special license plates. For the purposes of this section, a military assault force is a 141 unit or element of the armed forces of the United States engaged in or charged with the invasion or 142 capture of territory under the control of enemy forces.

143 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 144 plates issued under this section.

145 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 146 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

147 § 46.2-746.2:2. Special license plates; members and former members of the 173rd Airborne 148 Brigade.

149 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 150 member or former member of the 173rd Airborne Brigade, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant 151 special license plates.

152 The provisions of subdivisions 1 and 2 of subsection B of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license 153 plates issued under this section.

154 No license plates shall be issued under this section unless and until a one-time fee of \$3,500 shall 155 have been paid to the Commissioner.

156 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section may also be issued special license plates under this section. 157 158

§ 46.2-746.2:3. Members and former members of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard).

159 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 160 member or former member of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard), the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to members and former members of the 3rd Infantry Regiment (Old Guard). 161

162 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 163 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

§ 46.2-746.2:4. Members of the Special Forces Association; fee.

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165 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 166 member of the Special Forces Association, the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license 167 plates.

168 The provisions of subdivisions B 1 and 2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under 169 this section.

170 No license plates provided for in this section shall be issued unless and until the Commissioner 171 receives at least 50 prepaid applications therefor and payment of a one-time fee of \$3,500, less the total 172 amount of \$10 annual fees collected from the prepaid applications received.

173 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 174 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

175 § 46.2-746.2:6. Special license plates; members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United 176 States organization.

177 On receipt of an application therefor and presentation of written evidence that the applicant is a 178 member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States organization, the Commissioner shall 179 issue special license plates to the applicant.

180 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 181 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

182 § 46.2-746.3. Special license plates for members or veterans of certain military reserve

183 organizations.

184 The Commissioner, on application therefor, shall issue special license plates to members or veterans 185 of the Air Force Reserve, the Army Reserve, the Coast Guard Reserve, the Marine Reserve, and the 186 Naval Reserve. Such special license plates may, when feasible, bear decals or stickers identifying the 187 reserve organization of which the applicant is or was a member.

188 The provisions of subdivision B^2 of § 46.2-725 shall not apply to license plates issued under this 189 section.

190 Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 191 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 192

§ 46.2-746.5. Special license plates for National Guard retirees; fees.

193 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is a retired member of the National Guard, the Commissioner shall issue special license plates to National Guard retirees. 194

195 No fee shall be charged for license plates issued under the provisions of this section to retired 196 members of the Virginia National Guard.

The fee for non-Virginia National Guard retirees shall be \$10 per year plus the prescribed cost for 197 198 state license plates, unless the plates bear reserved numbers or letters as provided for in § 46.2-726. In 199 this latter case, such license plates shall be subject to an additional charge of \$10 per year for the 200 reserved numbers or letters.

Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 201 202 may also be issued special license plates under this section.

§ 46.2-749.46. Special license plates; naval aviators. 203

204 On receipt of an application and written evidence that the applicant is or has been a naval aviator, 205 the Commissioner shall issue to the applicant special license plates.

Unremarried surviving spouses of persons eligible to receive special license plates under this section 206 may also be issued special license plates under this section. 207
