That §§ 3.2-4780, 3.2-4782, and 3.2-4783 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as 10 follows: 11 § 3.2-4780. Definitions. 12 As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning: 13 "Charitable food assistance organization" means an organization operating in Virginia that provides 14 nutrition assistance to relieve situations of emergency and distress through the provision of food to 15 needy persons in Virginia. "Fund" means the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Fund. 16 17 "VAFA Program" means the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program. "Wholesome food" means food that meets all quality standards imposed by federal, state, and local 18 19 laws or regulations that is readily marketable. 20 § 3.2-4782. Authority of Commissioner. 21 A. The Commissioner shall establish the Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program (VAFA Program) for Virginia farmers and food producers to donate, sell, or otherwise provide agriculture 22 23 products to charitable food assistance organizations. 24 B. The Commissioner may contract with charitable food assistance organizations operating in 25 Virginia or regional charitable food assistance organizations to carry out the provisions of this chapter. C. The Commissioner shall provide grants from the Fund to charitable food assistance organizations 26 to reimburse farmers or food producers for any costs associated with harvesting, processing, packaging, 27 28 or transporting agriculture products or wholesome foods donated, sold, or otherwise provided to such 29 charitable food assistance organizations. D. The Commissioner may develop guidelines and adopt regulations to carry out the provisions of 30 31 this chapter. Such regulations shall prohibit any charitable food assistance organization that contracts 32 with or receives a grant from the Commissioner from attributing more than 10 percent of the total grant 33 or contract amount to administrative costs. 34 § 3.2-4783. Virginia Agriculture Food Assistance Program. 35 The VAFA Program shall: 36 1. Provide grants from the Fund to charitable food assistance organizations to reimburse farmers or 37 food producers for any costs associated with harvesting, processing, packaging, or transporting 38 agriculture products or wholesome foods donated to such charitable food assistance organizations; and 39 2. Distribute agriculture products to needy persons in Virginia in accordance with the food 40 distribution guidelines for each charitable food assistance organization.
