11	1. That § 22.1-289.059 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 22.1-289.059. Possession and administration of an appropriate weight-based dosage of
13	epinephrine by employees.
14	A. The Board shall amend its regulations to require each early childhood care and education entity
15	child day center to implement policies for the possession and administration of epinephrine in every
16	such entity center to be administered by any nurse at the entity center, employee at the entity center, or
17	employee of a local health department who is authorized by a prescriber and trained in the
18	administration of epinephrine to any child believed to be having an anaphylactic reaction. Such policies
19	shall require that at least one school nurse, employee at the entity center, or employee of a local health
20	department who is authorized by a prescriber and trained in the administration of epinephrine has the
21	means to access at all times during regular facility hours any such appropriate weight-based dosage of
22	eninenhrine that is stored in a locked or otherwise generally inaccessible container or area

B. The Board shall amend its regulations to require each family day home provider or at least one other caregiver employed by such provider in the family day home to be trained in the administration of

25 epinephrine and to notify the parents of each child who receives care in such family day home whether

26 the provider stores an appropriate weight-based dosage of epinephrine in the residence or home in27 which the family day home operates.
