10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 51.1-309 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 51.1-309. Appearance as counsel in certain forums prohibited.
13	A. No former justice or judge of a court of record of the Commonwealth and no former full-time
14	judge of a court not of record of the Commonwealth, who is retired and receiving retirement benefits
15	under the provisions of the Judicial Retirement System, shall appear as counsel in any case in any court
16	of the Commonwealth.
17	B. No former member of the State Corporation Commission or Virginia Workers' Compensation
18	Commission, who is retired and receiving retirement benefits under the provisions of the Judicial
19	Retirement System, shall appear as counsel in any case before the Commission of which he was
20	formerly a member.
21	C. The provisions of subsection A shall not be applicable if (i) the retired justice or judge has been
22	retired for at least two years and is not authorized for or assigned to temporary recall by the Chief
23	Justice of the Supreme Court, the Chief Judge of the Court of Appeals, or the Senate Committee on the
24	Judiciary and the House Committee for Courts of Justice; (ii) the retired justice or judge is appearing as
25	counsel, pro bono, for an indigent person in a civil matter; (iii) such civil matter is assigned or referred
26	to the retired justice or judge by a nonprofit legal aid program organized under the auspices of the
27	Virginia State Bar; and (iv) the retired justice or judge is not an employee, officer, or board member of
28	such nonprofit legal aid program; and (v) the retired justice or judge is at least 67 years of age and is
29 30	eligible to receive full social security benefits. Nothing herein shall relieve the retired justice or judge from having obtained any license or meeting any requirement in connection with the appearance as
30 31	from having obtained any license or meeting any requirement in connection with the appearance as
31	counsel as required by law, rule, or regulation.
