23107242D **SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 189** 1 2 Offered February 24, 2023 3 Celebrating the life of George Robert Smith, Jr., MD. 4 Patron—Suetterlein 5 6 Unanimous consent to introduce 7 8 WHEREAS, George Robert Smith, Jr., MD, a country doctor in Shawsville who touched countless 9 lives throughout Montgomery County, died on February 18, 2023; and WHEREAS, a native of North Carolina, Robert "Bob" Smith served his country as a member of the 10 United States Navy, then attended the University of North Carolina and Harvard Medical School; and 11 WHEREAS, while completing his residency at what was then the Medical College of Virginia, Bob 12 Smith and his wife, Mildred, passed through Shawsville and asked if the town needed a doctor; they 13 subsequently established a medical practice, the Alleghany Clinic, in the former Meadow Brook Home 14 on U.S. 460; and 15 WHEREAS, Bob Smith convinced a friend and fellow doctor, Clarence W. Taylor, Jr., MD, to join 16 17 the practice in 1957; the Smith and Taylor families later built homes nearby on a road now named Pair 18 O'Docs Lane; and 19 WHEREAS, over the course of his 42-year career as a family physician, Bob Smith treated patients 20 in need at all hours of the day, seven days a week, and commonly made house calls, serving different 21 generations of the same local families; and 22 WHEREAS, in the 1960s, Bob Smith began construction on Meadowbrook Nursing Home, which 23 served older residents of the community for decades and became Montgomery County's largest 24 employer; and 25 WHEREAS, in 1982, Bob Smith established the Mountain Valley Charitable Foundation, which 26 awarded scholarships to aspiring nurses; after Meadowbrook Nursing Home closed in 2001, the 27 foundation led efforts to repurpose the building as the Meadowbrook Center, which houses a library, a 28 wellness center, a museum, an art gallery, and the Dr. George R. Smith, Jr., Community Center; and 29 WHEREAS, with Bob Smith as president, the Mountain Valley Charitable Foundation also 30 transformed an old fire station into a food pantry and thrift shop; and 31 WHEREAS, in addition, Bob Smith helped found the Shawsville Rescue Squad and the Shawsville 32 Ruritan Club: and 33 WHEREAS, Bob Smith will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by his wife of 73 years, 34 Mildred; his children, George III, Julia, Mary Beth, and Linda, and their families; and numerous other family members, friends, and former patients; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED, That the Senate of Virginia hereby note with great sadness the loss of George Robert 35 36 37 Smith, Jr., MD, a pillar of the Shawsville community; and, be it RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Clerk of the Senate prepare a copy of this resolution for 38 39 presentation to the family of George Robert Smith, Jr., MD, as an expression of the Senate of Virginia's 40 respect for his memory.
