- **4. Title:** Human trafficking; practitioners regulated by Dept. of Health Professions, etc., required training.

Summary:** The bill, as amended, would require that any licensee of the Board of Medicine may be required by the Board to complete up to two hours of Type 1 continuing learning activities or courses in a specific subject area. If the Board designates a subject area for continuing learning activities or courses out of the hours of continuing education required for biennial licensure renewal, it shall publish such requirement no later than January 1 of the first year of the term of the license for which the specific learning activity or course is required. If the Board of Medicine designates a subject area for continuing learning activities or courses pursuant to this act, the first subject area shall be on the topic of human trafficking.
