**4. Title:**    Retired state law-enforcement officers; retention of badge.

**5. Summary:** The bill provides that on and after July 1, 2023, upon the retirement of a law-enforcement officer who is employed by an agency of the Commonwealth at the time of retirement, the employing department or agency must award the retiree their badge or other insignia upon request by the retiree, provided that the badge or insignia is mounted in such a manner that it will be impossible for anyone to display such badge or insignia upon their person.
