**4. Title:**    Conveyance of easement.

**5. Summary:** Authorizes the Department of Conservation and Recreation to grant and convey an easement and right-of-way at High Bridge Trail State Park to Roy B. Stanton, Jr., and Pearl J. Stanton. The easement, which will follow an existing driveway across a portion of the High Bridge Trail State Park, will allow ingress and egress from U.S. Highway 460 to the Stantons' property.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that the Department of Conservation and Recreation can implement the provisions of this bill within current resources.
