4. Title: Waterworks and wastewater works operators; license reciprocity.

5. Summary: Requires the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (the Department) to issue a reciprocal license for waterworks and wastewater works operators licensed in another state upon application by an individual and without examination. Such license is to be issued if the applicant holds a license or certificate issued by another state in a profession or occupation with a similar scope of practice, if the applicant has held the license or certification for at least three years, if the applicant had to pass an examination to obtain the license or certification, if the applicant is in good standing and has no pending investigations or unresolved complaints against them, if the application does not have a disqualifying criminal record, if no other state has imposed certain discipline on the applicant, and if the applicant pays all applicable fees.
