3. Committee: Passed both Houses

4. Title: Oyster-planting grounds; fees.

5. Summary: Increases the fee for transferring a riparian planting ground assignment from \$5 to \$100 when ownership of such riparian assignment is transferred with ownership of the adjacent highland. The bill also eliminates the consideration of certain factors as a requirement for the Commissioner when recording applications for transfers or assignments.
