Summary: Requires a health insurance carrier that credentials the physicians, mental health professionals, or other providers in its network to establish reasonable protocols and procedures for processing of new provider credentialing applications. The bill requires such protocols and procedures to require the carrier toto approve or deny new provider credentialing applications within60 days of receiving a completed application and to provide notice to the new provider applicant that the provider's application is received and complete. The bill also requires payment no later than 30 days after the carrier approves the new provider credentialing application for services that are rendered from the date the new provider applicant's completed credentialing application is provided to the carrier for consideration.
