The bill allows an employee to work at a remote location only if certain requirements are met, including the establishment of written policies and procedures for remote work supervision; compliance with security plans and federal and state security requirements; the proper maintenance of physical records; access of the licensee's secure systems via a virtual private network with password protection; the installation and maintenance of security updates; and the designation of the principal place of business as the licensee's registered location for the purposes of the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System and Registry record.
