5.	Summary: Defines "office" and "remote location," as those terms apply to the licensing of mortgage lenders and mortgage brokers, and permits licensees to allow employees and independent contractors to work from a remote location.
	The bill permits a licensee to allow an employee or exclusive agent to work from a remote location if certain requirements are met, including the establishment of written policies and procedures for remote work supervision; compliance with information security plans and federal and state security requirements; appropriate risk-based monitoring and oversight processes and agreement to comply with the established processes; the proper maintenance of physical records; access to the licensee's secure systems via a virtual private network with password protection; the installation and maintenance of security updates; and the designation of the principal place of business as the licensee's registered location for the purposes of the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System and Registry record.
