4. Title: Virginia Consumer Protection Act; prohibited practices; kratom products.

5. Summary: Provides that it is a prohibited practice under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act to sell or offer for sale (i) any kratom product, defined in the bill, to a person younger than 21 years of age or (ii) any kratom product that does not include a label listing all ingredients and with the following guidance: “This product may be harmful to your health, has not been evaluated by the FDA, and is not intended to diagnose, treat, cure, or prevent any disease.”
