4. Title: Association health plans; premium rates based on employer member's risk profile.

Summary: Provides that for association health plans, an insurer may (i) establish base rates formed on an actuarially sound, modified community rating methodology that considers the pooling of all participant claims and (ii) utilize each employer member's specific risk profile to determine premium rates for each employer member by actuarially adjusting above or below established base rates.
