9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: The bill applies to all public bodies subject to the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA). The bill does not apply to higher education institutions operating under Management Agreements and Memoranda of Understanding in the operational area of procurement (currently, 13 Level III and Level II institutions). Further, the bill does not apply to local governments that have exempted themselves from the VPPA pursuant to subdivisions A 9, 10, and 11 of Va. Code § 2.2-4343.
