- 5. Summary: Requires the Board of Education to report to the General Assembly no later than October 1, 2023 regarding the creation and maintenance of a Virginia parent data portal that, among other things, (i) displays individualized student assessment data on all state-supported assessments, as that term is defined in the bill, currently and cumulatively over time (ii) provides a description of the purpose of each state-supported assessment, an explanation of how to interpret student data on each state-supported assessment, and a comparison of a student's performance on each state-supported assessment with the performance of the student's school, the student's school division, and the Commonwealth; (iii) be viewable from a mobile device in addition to a desktop computer; and (iv) restricts to students and their parents.

- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary, see item 8.
- **8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would require the Board of Education (BOE) to report to the General Assembly recommendations for the creation and maintenance of a Virginia parent data portal. The Department of Education (DOE) can absorb this work within existing appropriation.

DOE estimates that if a requirement to create and maintain a parent data portal is implemented in future years an additional \$3 million in onetime funds and \$2.5 million in recurring funds may be needed. Any actual future impact is indeterminate at this time and would depend on the recommendations adopted.
