6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 24.2-520 of the Code of Virginia, relating to elections; candidates for
7	office; conduct of primaries; declaration of candidacy.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 24.2-520 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 24.2-520. Declaration of candidacy required.
11	A candidate for nomination by primary for any office shall be required to file a written declaration
12	of candidacy on a form prescribed by the State Board. The declaration shall include the name of the
13	political party of which the candidate is a member, a designation of the office for which he is a
14	candidate, and a statement that, if the candidate withdraws from or is defeated in the primary, his name
15	is not to be printed on the ballots for that office in the succeeding general election. The declaration shall

15 is not to be printed on the ballots for that office in the succeeding general election. The declaration shall16 be acknowledged before some officer who has the authority to take acknowledgments to deeds, or17 attested by two witnesses who are qualified voters of the election district.
