Fiscal Implications:** This fiscal impact statement has been revised to more accurately reflect that the program affected by this bill is charitable solicitations and remove the estimated revenue impact in FY 2024. Charitable solicitations is a nongeneral fund program, and all expenses are paid from revenue generated from the fees. This bill will reduce fees such that the program revenue will more closely match expenditures. The Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services can absorb this reduction and has enough cash balance to support ongoing operations. Annual expenditures total approximately \$1.4 million.
