**4. Title:** School-connected overdose policies; guidelines, parental notification and response.

**5. Summary:** Requires the Board of Education to establish guidelines for school-connected overdose response and parental notification policies to aid local school boards in the implementation of such policies, including (a) a model action plan for each school board to follow in responding to the overdose, including communicating and coordinating with the Department of Education and the local law-enforcement liaison or local law-enforcement agency that employs the school resource officers for such school division, and (b) criteria for issuing parental notification to ensure sensitivity to the privacy interests of any affected individuals and compliance with any applicable laws, rules, regulations relating to the disclosure and protection of a minor's personal, confidential, or otherwise sensitive information.
