A BILL to amend and reenact §§ 2.1-1.7 and 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding sections numbered 51.5-9.01, 51.5-25.1, and 63.1-84 relating to the creation of the Statewide Independent Living Council, the Statewide Rehabilitation Services Advisory Council and the Statewide Rehabilitation Services Advisory Council for the Blind.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That §§ 2.1-1.7 and 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is amended by adding sections numbered 51.5-9.01, 51.5-25.1, and 63.1-84 as follows:

§ 2.1-1.7. State councils.

A. There shall be, in addition to such others as may be established by law, the following permanent collegial bodies either affiliated with more than one agency or independent of an agency within the executive branch:

190 § 51.5-25.1. *Statewide Independent Living Council created.*—

191 *The Statewide Independent Living Council is hereby created to jointly plan with the Department of*
192 *Rehabilitative Services activities carried out under Title VII of the federal Rehabilitation Act and to*
193 *provide advice to the Department regarding such activities. Membership and duties shall be constructed*
194 *according to federal provisions. The Department of Rehabilitative Services shall provide staff support*
195 *for the Council.*

196 § 63.1-84. *Statewide Rehabilitation Advisory Council for the Blind created.*—*The Statewide*
197 *Rehabilitation Advisory Council for the Blind is hereby created to provide advice to the Department for*
198 *the Visually Handicapped regarding vocational services provided pursuant to Title I and Title VI of the*
199 *federal Rehabilitation Act. Membership and duties shall be constructed according to federal provisions.*
