6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 40 of Chapter 343 of the Acts of Assembly of 1928 is amended and reenacted as follows:**
8 **CHAPTER VII**

9 **JUDGE AND CLERK OF CIRCUIT COURT, COMMONWEALTH'S ATTORNEY, ~~CLERK CITY~~**
10 **TREASURER AND OTHER OFFICERS**

11 § 40. Judge and clerk of circuit court, Commonwealth's attorney, city treasurer, city sheriff and
12 commissioner of revenue.

13 A. There shall be for said city a judge of the ~~corporation~~ circuit court, a Commonwealth's attorney, a
14 clerk of the ~~corporation~~ circuit court, a treasurer, a ~~sergeant~~ sheriff, and a commissioner of the revenue,
15 each of which shall be elected in the manner and at the time, and to hold office for the term prescribed
16 by law; they shall respectively perform such duties, have such powers, and be liable to such penalties as
17 may be prescribed by the laws of the ~~State Commonwealth~~ or the ordinances of the city, made in
18 pursuance thereof; and for all services performed for said city by the treasurer or by the commissioner
19 of revenue, or performed under any ordinance or resolution of the council, such officers shall receive
20 such compensation as may from time to time be fixed by the council, which compensation may be
21 either in the shape of salary or commissions as the council may determine.

22 B. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the sheriff shall, upon the adoption of an
23 ordinance by the city council, in addition to the other duties and responsibilities imposed upon him by
24 general law, be responsible for the operation of the city jail, lockup facilities, receiving unit and court
25 holding facilities.

26 **2. That an emergency exists and this act is in force from its passage.**
