#### 7 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 8 1. That § 2.1-190.1 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

the issuance of duplicate warrant checks.

9 § 2.1-190.1. Admissibility of reproductions of checks in evidence; compliance with subpoena.

10 A. A reproduction of any check or draft drawn by the Treasurer of Virginia, when satisfactorily identified, is as admissible in evidence as the original itself in any judicial or administrative proceeding, 11 12 civil or criminal, whether the original is in existence or not and a satisfactorily identified enlargement of such reproduction is likewise admissible. The introduction of a reproduced check or draft or of an 13 14 enlargement thereof does not preclude admission of the original. Any such check or draft, reproduction 15 or enlargement purporting to be sealed, or sealed and signed, or signed alone by the State Treasurer or on his behalf by a designated an employee of the Department of Treasury Commonwealth of Virginia 16 designated by the State Treasurer, may be considered satisfactorily identified and admitted as evidence, 17 18 without any proof of the seal or signature, or of the official character of the person whose name is 19 signed to it.

20 B. The State Treasurer and each employee of the Department of Treasury or an employee of the Commonwealth of Virginia designated by the State Treasurer, when served with any summons, 21 22 subpoena, subpoena duces tecum or order, directing him to produce any check or draft kept by or in the 23 possession of the Department of Treasury any agency or institution of the Commonwealth, may comply 24 therewith by certifying a reproduction or enlargement thereof in accordance with the preceding 25 subsection and mailing such reproduction or enlargement in a sealed envelope to the clerk of court. 26 Upon good cause shown, any court may direct the Treasurer or any employee of the Department of 27 Treasury an employee of the Commonwealth of Virginia designated by the State Treasurer to appear 28 personally, notwithstanding any other provision of this section.
