The Authority is hereby empowered to *pledge its funds, and* make loans and grants *to or* for the 11 12 benefit of qualified private, for-profit enterprises and public; governmental or corporate 13 instrumentalities in the coalfield region of Virginia (including any political subdivision of the 14 Commonwealth and the Breaks Interstate Park); or not-for-profit enterprises, nonprofit industrial 15 16 development corporations, or industrial development authorities for financing the following: 17 1. Purchase of real estate; 18 2. Grading of site(s); 19 3. Construction of flood control dams; 20 4. Water, sewer, natural gas and/or electrical line replacement and/or extensions; 21 5. Construction or rehabilitation or expansion of buildings; 22 6. Construction of parking facilities; 23 7. Access roads construction and street improvements; 24 8. Purchase or lease of machinery and tools; 25 9. Performing any Such other improvements as are deemed necessary by the Authority to meet its objectives accomplish the purposes for which it was created; and 26

10. Construction of improvements at the Breaks Interstate Park as set forth in § 15.1-1646.1 outside

the Commonwealth if in the Breaks Interstate Park.

2. That § 15.1-1646.1 of the Code of Virginia is repealed.
