| 13 | As a condition to employment, every public school employee, including without limitation teachers, |
| 14 | cafeteria workers, janitors and bus drivers, shall submit a certificate signed by a licensed physician, or |
| 15 | by a registered nurse licensed pursuant to Article 2 (§ 54.1-3016 et seq.) of Chapter 30 of Title 54.1 |
| 16 | and employed by a local health department, stating that such employee appears free of communicable |
| 17 | tuberculosis. Such certificate shall be based on recorded results of such skin tests, X rays and other |
| 18 | examinations, singly or in combination, as are deemed necessary by the a licensed physician that have |
| 19 | been performed within the twelve months' period immediately preceding submission of the certificate. |
| 20 | After consulting with the local health director, any school board may require the submission of such |
| 21 | certificates annually, or at such intervals as it deems appropriate, as a condition to continued |
| 22 | employment. |
