A BILL to amend and reenact § 19.2-12 of the Code of Virginia, relating to conservators of the peace.

Referred to Committee for Courts of Justice

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

1. That § 19.2-12 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

§ 19.2-12. Who are conservators of the peace.

Every judge throughout the Commonwealth and every magistrate within the geographical area for which he is appointed or elected, shall be a conservator of the peace. In addition, every commissioner in chancery, while sitting as such commissioner, and any special agent of the United States Department of Justice, Department of Treasury, Department of Agriculture, Department of State, and Department of Interior, any inspector and special investigator of the United States Postal Inspection Service, any officer of the National Marine Fisheries Service of the United States Department of Commerce, and any United States marshal or deputy United States marshal whose duties involve the enforcement of the criminal laws of the United States, any officer of the Virginia Marine Patrol, any criminal investigator of the United States Department of Labor, and any civilian special agent of the United States Naval Investigative Service shall be a conservator of the peace.
