## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact § 18.2-26 of the Code of Virginia, relating to attempted second degree 3 murder.

[H 479] Approved Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 18.2-26 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 18.2-26. Attempts to commit noncapital felonies; how punished. Every person who attempts to commit an offense which is a noncapital felony shall be punished as

10 follows:

11 (1) If the felony attempted is punishable by a maximum punishment of life imprisonment or a term of years in excess of twenty years, an attempt thereat shall be punishable as a Class 4 felony. 12

13 (2) If the felony attempted is punishable by a maximum punishment of twenty years' imprisonment, an attempt thereat shall be punishable as a Class 5 felony. (3) If the felony attempted is punishable by a maximum punishment of less than twenty years' 14

15 imprisonment, an attempt thereat shall be punishable as a Class 6 felony. 16
