7 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**8 **1. That § 60.2-623 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

9 § 60.2-623. Procedure generally; confidentiality of information.

10 A. The manner in which disputed claims shall be presented, reports required from the claimant and
11 from employers, the conduct of hearings and appeals before any deputy, appeal tribunal or the
12 Commission, and transcripts prepared shall be in accordance with regulations prescribed by the
13 Commission for determining the rights of the parties. Such regulations need not conform to common law
14 or statutory rules of evidence and other technical rules of procedure. A full and complete record shall be
15 kept of all proceedings in connection with a disputed claim. All testimony at any hearing upon a
16 disputed claim shall be recorded, but need not be transcribed unless the disputed claim is further
17 appealed and a timely request for a hearing before the Commission has been made in accordance with
18 regulations prescribed by the Commission.

19 B. Information furnished the Commission under the provisions of this chapter shall not be published
20 or be open to public inspection, other than to public employees in the performance of their public
21 duties. Such information shall not be used in any judicial or administrative proceeding other than one
22 arising out of the provisions of this title; *however, the Commission shall make its records about a*
23 *claimant available to the Workers' Compensation Commission if it requests such records. However, The*
24 Commission may *also*, in its discretion, furnish copies of the transcript of hearings to any party.
