3 *vehicles.*

6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 46.2-1105 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 46.2-1105. Width of vehicles generally; exceptions.

9 No vehicle, including any load thereon, but excluding the mirror required by § 46.2-1082 and any
10 warning device installed on a school bus pursuant to § 46.2-1090, shall exceed a total outside width as
11 follows:

12 1. Passenger bus operated in an incorporated city or town when authorized under § 46.2-1300 - 102
13 inches;

14 2. School buses - 100 inches;

15 3. *Recreational vehicles - 102 inches with safety devices not to exceed 3 inches on each side of the*
16 *vehicle, excluding rear view mirrors. For purposes of this section, recreational vehicle means every*
17 *vehicular-type unit primarily designed as temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, travel or*
18 *seasonal use, that either has its own motive power or is mounted on, or is towed by another vehicle.*
19 *The basic entities are: travel trailer, fifth wheel trailer, camping trailer, and motor home;*

20 4. Other vehicles - 96 inches with safety devices not to exceed 3 inches on each side of the vehicle,
21 excluding rear view mirrors.
