Signals by law-enforcement officers and crossing guards. 9 A. Law-enforcement officers may assume control of traffic at any intersection, regardless of whether 10 such intersection is controlled by lights, controlled by other traffic control devices, or uncontrolled. 11 Whenever any law-enforcement officer so assumes control of traffic, all drivers of vehicles shall obey his 12 signals. 13 B. Law-enforcement officers and uniformed school crossing guards may assume control of traffic

otherwise controlled by lights, and in such event, signals by such officers and uniformed crossing guards shall take precedence over such traffic control devices.
