5 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**6 **1. That § 2.1-726 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

7 § 2.1-726. Definitions.

8 As used in this chapter:

9 "Accounts receivable" refers to the classification of debts due the Commonwealth, *including*
10 *judgments, fines, costs, and penalties imposed upon conviction for criminal and traffic offenses, and as*
11 *defined in the guidelines promulgated by the State Comptroller.*12 "Discharge" means the compromise and settlement of disputes, claims, and controversies of the
13 Commonwealth by the office of the Attorney General as authorized by § 2.1-127.14 "Past-due" means any account receivable for which payment has not been received by the payment
15 due date.16 "State agency and institution" means any authority, board, department, instrumentality, agency or
17 other unit *in any branch* of state government. The term shall not include any county, city or town, or
18 any local or regional governmental authority or any "nonstate agency" as defined in the Appropriations
19 Act.20 "Write-off" means a transaction to remove from an agency's financial accounting records an account
21 receivable that management has determined to be uncollectible.
