10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 33.1-252 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 33.1-252. (Effective October 1, 1993) Free use of toll bridges, etc., by certain state officers and
13	employees; penalties.
14	A. Upon presentation of a toll pass issued pursuant to regulations promulgated by the Commonwealth
15	Transportation Board, the following persons may use all toll bridges, toll ferries, toll tunnels, and toll
15 16	roads in this Commonwealth without the payment of toll:
17	1. The Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner;
18	2. Members of the Commonwealth Transportation Board;
10 19	3. Employees of the Virginia Department of Transportation;
20	4. The Superintendent of the Department of State Police;
20 21	5. Officers and employees of the Department of State Police;
22	6. Members of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board;
23	7. Employees of the regulatory and hearings divisions of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage
24	Control and special agents of the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control;
25	8., 9. [Repealed.]
26	10. The Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles;
27	11. Employees of the Department of Motor Vehicles;
28 29	12. Employees of the enforcement division of the State Corporation Commission;
29 30	13. Local police officers;14. Sheriffs and their deputies; and
30 31	15. Persons operating fire-fighting equipment and ambulances owned by a political subdivision of the
32	Commonwealth or a nonprofit association or corporation.
32 33	B. Any tollgate keeper who shall refuse to permit the persons listed in subsection A of this section to
33 34	pass through such tollgate or over such toll bridge or ferry, or toll road or toll tunnel upon presentation
35	of such a toll pass, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not more than fifty
35 36	dollars, and not less than two dollars and fifty cents. Any person other than those listed in subsection A
37	of this section who shall exhibit any such toll pass for the purpose of using any toll bridge, toll tunnel
38	or ferry shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor and punished accordingly.
39	B1. Any vehicle operated by the holder of a valid driver's license issued by Virginia or any other
40	state shall be allowed free use of all toll bridges, toll roads, and other toll facilities in Virginia, except
4 1	the Norfolk-Virginia Beach Expressway, if:
42	1. The vehicle is specially equipped to permit its operation by a handicapped person;
43	2. The driver of the vehicle has been certified, either by a physician licensed by Virginia or any
44	other state or by the Adjudication Office of the United States Veterans Administration, as being severely
45	physically disabled and having permanent upper limb mobility or dexterity impairments which
4 6	substantially impair his ability to deposit coins in toll baskets;
47	3. The driver has applied for and received from the Department of Transportation a vehicle window
48	sticker identifying him as eligible for such free passage; and
4 9	4. Such identifying window sticker is properly displayed on the vehicle.
5 0	A copy of this subsection shall be posted at all toll bridges, toll roads, and other toll facilities in
50 51	Virginia. The Department of Transportation shall provide envelopes for payments of tolls by those
51 52	persons exempted from tolls pursuant to this subsection and shall accept any payments made by such
52 53	persons exempted from tons pursuant to this subsection and shan accept any payments made by such persons.
55 54	C. Nothing contained in this section or in § 33.1-251 or § 33.1-285 shall operate to affect the
54 55	provisions of § 22.1-187.
55 56	D. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections A and B of this section, only the following persons
50 57	may use the Chesapeake Bay Bridge-Tunnel or facilities of the Richmond Metropolitan Authority
57 58	without the payment of toll when necessary and incidental to the conduct of official business:
59	1. The Commonwealth Transportation Commissioner;
• •	The common ventur transportation commissioner,

- 62 4. The Superintendent of the Department of State Police;

- 67 E. Vehicles transporting three or more persons, including the driver, shall be permitted toll-free use
- of the Dulles Toll Road during rush hours as defined by regulation of the Commonwealth 68

- 2. That the provisions of this act shall become effective on July 1, 1994, unless, prior to that date, the Commonwealth Transportation Board issues a written finding that implementation of the 70

- 72 provision of this act would unduly interfere with the bond funding of the Dulles Toll Road.
