**HOUSE BILL NO. 990****AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE**

(Proposed by the House Committee for Courts of Justice)

House Amendments in [ ] — February 15, 1994

*A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Title 54.1 a section numbered 54.1-2409.1, relating to criminal penalties for practicing certain professions and occupations without appropriate license.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:****1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Title 54.1 a section numbered 54.1-2409.1 as follows:**

*[ § 54.1-2409.1. Criminal penalties for practicing certain professions and occupations without appropriate license. ]*

*[ A. ] Any person who, without holding a current valid license, issued by a regulatory board pursuant to this title (i) performs an invasive procedure for which a license is required; (ii) administers, prescribes, sells, distributes, or dispenses a controlled drug; or (iii) practices a profession or occupation after having his license to do so suspended or revoked [ , and after having been so notified, ] shall be guilty of a Class 6 felony.*
