| 23 | the necessary expenses of the government, or to pay the indebtedness of the Commonwealth. |
| 24 | The rates for the state income tax and the retail sales and use tax shall not be increased unless |
| 25 | authorized by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house of the General |
| 26 | Assembly. |
