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## VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact § 56-484.2 of the Code of Virginia, relating to telephone exchanges;
 extension or reduction of local service areas.

6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
7 1. That § 56-484.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
§ 56-484.2. Extension or reduction upon poll of certain subscribers.
9 A. Upon petition of five percent but in no case less than twenty-five of the subscribers in an
10 established telephone exchange for an extension or reduction of their local service area to include or
11 exclude a contiguous local exchange or exchanges, the Commission shall estimate the approximate

11 12 change in the monthly rate for service which will result from such extension or reduction. The 13 Commission shall order the affected company or companies to poll those subscribers whose monthly rate 14 for service would change if the proposed changes were adopted. However, polls shall not be required in 15 the exchange or exchanges to which the petitioners desire an extension of local service if (i) any resulting rate increases in any twelve-month period do not, in the aggregate, exceed five percent of the 16 existing monthly one-party residential flat rate service for the affected exchange to which the petitioners 17 18 desire an extension of local service or (ii) any resulting rate increases in any twelve-month period, in the 19 aggregate, exceed five percent solely due to rate regrouping. If subscriber polls are not required, the 20 Commission shall proceed pursuant to the provisions of § 56-237.2. No more than one petition for a poll from the same group of subscribers shall be considered by the Commission during any three-year period. 21

22 B. If a poll is required pursuant to subsection A and a majority of the subscribers are in favor of the 23 proposed change, or if the Commission determines that more than fifty percent of the subscribers have 24 voted in the poll and that a majority of those voting are in favor of the proposed change, the 25 Commission shall order the extension or reduction of their local service area. For the purposes of this 26 section, the number of subscribers in an established telephone exchange shall be deemed to be the 27 number of subscribers in an exchange as of January 1 of the calendar year when the petition is 28 submitted to the Commission. Ballots polling subscribers on a proposed change in local service area 29 shall be counted sixty days after being mailed and the results certified to the Commission.

C. If a poll is not required pursuant to subsection A, the Commission shall require notice to
customers in exchanges in which polls are not required and shall convene a hearing on the proposed
extension or reduction of the local calling area if the lesser of five percent or 150 of the customers
within such exchanges request a hearing. The Commission may convene a hearing under this subsection
on its own motion without regard to the number of customers who request a hearing.

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
