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### VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

2 An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.1-1.7, 9-6.23 as it is currently effective and as it will become effective July 1, 1995, and 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia and to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Title 9 a chapter numbered 22.12, consisting of sections numbered 9-145.50 and 9-145.51, 3 4 5 relating to the establishment of the Virginia Technology Council.

Approved Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

8 9 1. That §§ 2.1-1.7, 9-6.23 as it is currently effective and as it will become effective July 1, 1995, and 9-6.25:1 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted and that the Code of Virginia is 10 amended by adding in Title 9 a chapter numbered 22.12, consisting of sections numbered 9-145.50 11 and 9-145.51, as follows: 12

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§ 9-6.23. (Effective until July 1, 1995) Prohibition against service by legislators on boards and commissions within the executive branch.

60 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards and commissions within the executive branch which are responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly. 61 62 Such prohibition shall not extend to boards and commissions engaged solely in policy studies or 63 commemorative activities. If any law directs the appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board or commission in the executive branch which is responsible for administering programs 64 65 established by the General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position. The provisions of this section shall not apply, however, to members of the Board for Branch Pilots, who shall be appointed as 66 67 provided for in § 54.1-901; to members of the Board on Veterans' Affairs, who shall be appointed as 68 provided for in § 2.1-741; to members of the Council on Indians, who shall be appointed as provided 69 70 for in § 9-138.1; to members of the Virginia Technology Council, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 9-145.51; to members of the Board of Trustees of the Southwest Virginia Higher Education 71 Center, who shall be appointed as provided in § 23-231.3; to members of the Maternal and Child Health Council, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 9-318; to members of the Virginia Interagency 72 73 74 Coordinating Council who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.1-750; to members of the Advisory 75 Council on the Virginia Business-Education Partnership Program, who shall be appointed as provided in 76 § 9-326; or to members of the Workforce 2000 Advocacy Council, who shall be appointed as provided 77 in § 2.1-116.18.

78 § 9-6.23. (Effective July 1, 1995) Prohibition against service by legislators on boards and commissions within the executive branch.

80 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards and commissions within the executive branch which are responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly. 81 Such prohibition shall not extend to boards and commissions engaged solely in policy studies or 82 commemorative activities. If any law directs the appointment of any member of the General Assembly 83 to a board or commission in the executive branch which is responsible for administering programs 84 85 established by the General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position. ### CHAPTER 22.12.

## VIRGINIA TECHNOLOGY COUNCIL.

- 219 § 9-145.50. Council established; duties.
- 220 The Virginia Technology Council is hereby established within the executive branch and shall be 221 referred to in this chapter as the Council. The Council shall perform the following functions: 222
  - 1. Work with the Commonwealth to develop and implement a statewide technology blueprint;
- 223 2. Be an advocate for technology-related issues at all levels of government and within the business 224 community;
- 225 3. Enhance the programs of local and regional technology councils, and encourage the establishment 226 of additional local and regional councils;
- 227 4. Work with local and regional councils in their effort to promote programs of research, 228 development, investment, and marketing for technology industries throughout the Commonwealth;
- 229 5. Strengthen the technology business sector and position Virginia as a leader in this industry so 230 vital to economic growth; and
- 6. Work with the Virginia World Technology Fair Commission to develop a comprehensive 231 232 technology infrastructure plan. 233
  - § 9-145.51. Membership; terms; chairman and vice chairman; staff.
- 234 A. The Council shall be composed of the following eighteen members: one member of the House of 235 Delegates to be appointed by the Speaker, one member of the Senate to be appointed by the Senate Committee on Privileges and Elections, the Secretary of Commerce and Trade, the Secretary of 236 Administration, the President of the Center for Innovative Technology, and a representative of the 237 238 Virginia Chamber of Commerce. After consultation with the regional technology councils and regional 239 Chambers of Commerce, the Governor shall appoint twelve members representing the geographic diversity of the Commonwealth. 240

241 B. The Council shall elect a chairman and a vice chairman from among its members and develop 242

by and govern the terms served by the members. C. Staff support for the Council shall be provided by the Northern Virginia Technology Council. There shall be no direct costs to the Commonwealth from the Council, and funding shall be secured 243 244 245 from private sources.
