Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 1. That § 15.1-33.4 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: § 15.1-33.4. Prohibiting loitering; curfew for minors.

Any *city or* town may prohibit loitering in, upon or around any public place whether Θr not on *public or* private property and may prohibit minors who are not attended by their parents from frequenting or being in public places whether Θr not on *public or* private property at such times as the governing body deems proper.
