15 A watershed improvement district shall have all of the powers of the soil and water conservation 16 district or districts in which the watershed improvement district is situated, and in addition shall have the authority to levy and collect a tax or service charge to be used for the purposes for which the watershed 17 18 improvement district was created. No tax shall be levied nor service charge imposed under this article unless two-thirds of the owners of land, which two-thirds owners shall also represent ownership of at 19 20 least two-thirds of the land area in such district, voting in a referendum called and held under 21 <u>§ 24.1-165</u> pursuant to regulations prescribed by the district directors, approve the levy of a tax to be 22 expended for the purposes of the watershed improvement district.

23 § 10.1-628. Fiscal powers of governing body; may poll landowners on question of incurring
 24 indebtedness or issuing bonds.

25 The governing body of any watershed improvement district shall have power, subject to the 26 conditions and limitations of this article, to incur indebtedness, borrow funds, and issue bonds of such 27 watershed improvement district. The circuit court of the county or city in which any portion of the 28 watershed improvement district is located, upon the petition of a majority of the members of the 29 governing body of the watershed improvement district, shall order a referendum at the next election 30 regularly prescribed by law, or at any other time not less than thirty days from the date of such order, 31 which shall be designated therein, to determine whether the governing body shall incur indebtedness or 32 issue bonds for one or more of the purposes for which the watershed improvement district was created.

The referendum shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by this article for the conduct of other referendums in the watershed improvement districts, and under 24.1-165.

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
