Child Abuse Center, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a charitable 13 14 organization within the context of Section δ (a) (6) of Article X of the Constitution of Virginia. 15 B. Property located in the City of Norfolk, owned by Child Abuse Center, Inc., and used by it 16 exclusively for charitable purposes on a nonprofit basis as set forth in subsection A of this section, is 17 hereby determined to be exempt from local taxation. 18 § 58.1-3650.611. Property of Wayside Foundation for the Arts, Inc. A. Wayside Foundation for the Arts, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, is hereby designated as a 19 20 charitable and benevolent organization within the context of Section 6 (a) (6) of Article X of the 21 Constitution of Virginia. 22 B.
