in special policemen in counties under the provisions of Article 3 (§ 15.1-144 et seq.) of Chapter 3 of
Title 15.1, except that they shall not have authority to execute civil process. Before any such policeman
shall enter upon the duties of his office, he shall enter into bond with approved security before the clerk
of the circuit court having jurisdiction over the county for which he is appointed in the penalty of
\$1,000, with condition for the faithful discharge of his official duties.
