6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 65.2-900 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 § 65.2-900. Records and reports of accidents.

9 A. Every employer shall keep a record of all injuries or deaths of its employees which occur in the
10 course of employment. Within ten days after the occurrence of such injury or death, and knowledge of
11 injury as provided in § 65.2-600, a ~~written~~ report of the injury or death shall be made ~~in duplicate~~ and
12 transmitted to the Commission by the employer ~~or~~ , its representative *or, in the case of an insured*
13 *employer, its insurance carrier, in accordance with regulations adopted by the Commission which may*
14 *authorize the transmission of such reports in written, magnetic, electronic or facsimile media.* The
15 Commission shall provide forms and instructions for reporting as required by this section. The
16 Commission shall provide the Department of Labor and Industry with a ~~copy of the report~~ *such reports.*

17 B. The accident report shall contain the name, nature and location of the business of the employer
18 and the name, age, sex and wages and occupation of the injured employee, and shall state the date and
19 hour of the accident causing the injury and the nature and cause of the injury, together with such other
20 information as may be required by the Commission. However, those injuries deemed minor by the
21 Commission shall be reported ~~on forms and~~ in the manner prescribed by the Commission.
