LD3771200 **HOUSE BILL NO. 1958** 1 234567 AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE (Proposed by the House Committee on Agriculture on January 26, 1995) (Patron Prior to Substitute—Delegate DeBoer) A BILL to amend and reenact § 3.1-796.70 of the Code of Virginia, relating to the sale of unweaned or certain immature animals; penalty. 8 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 9 1. That § 3.1-796.70 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows: 10 § 3.1-796.70. Sale, etc., of unweaned or certain immature animals prohibited, vaccinations required 11 for dogs and cats; penalty. A. No person shall sell, raffle, or offer for sale as pets or novelties, or offer or give as a prize, 12 13 premium, or advertising device any living chicks, ducklings, or other fowl under two months old in quantities of less than six or any unweaned mammalian companion animal or any dog under the age of 14 15 eight weeks without its dam, or any cat under the age of ten weeks without its queen. Dealers may offer 16 immature fowl, or unweaned mammalian companion animals, dogs under the age of eight weeks or cats under the age of ten weeks for sale as pets or novelties with the requirement that prospective owners 17 take possession of the animals only after fowl reach have reached two months of age and, mammalian 18 companion animals have been weaned, dogs are at least eight weeks of age, and cats are at least ten 19 20 weeks of age. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the sale of an unweaned animal (i) as food for other 21 animals or (ii) with the lactating dam or queen or a lactating surrogate dam or queen that has accepted 22 the animal. 23 B. Dealers shall provide all dogs and cats with current vaccinations against contagious and 24 infectious diseases, as recommended in writing and considered appropriate for the animal's age and 25 breed by a licensed veterinarian, at least five days before any new owner takes possession of the

26 animal. For dogs, the vaccinations required by this subsection shall include at a minimum canine
27 distemper, adenovirus type II parainfluenza, and parvovirus. For cats, the vaccinations required by this
28 subsection shall include at a minimum rhinotracheitis, calici, and panleukopenia. Dealers shall provide

**29** the new owner with the dog's or cat's immunization history.
