10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 19.2-73.2 as follows:
12	§ 19.2-73.2. Law-enforcement officers to issue subpoenas.
13	Law-enforcement officers as defined in § 9-169 and state police officers, in the course of their duties,
14	in the investigation of any Class 3 or Class 4 misdemeanor or any traffic infraction, may, within
15	seventy-two hours of the time of the offense, issue a subpoena to any witness to appear in court and
16	testify with respect to any such criminal charge or traffic infraction brought against any person as a
17 18	result of such investigation. The return of service thereof shall be made within seventy-two hours after service to the appropriate court clerk. A subpoena so issued shall have the same force and effect as if
10	issued by the court.
20	Any person failing to appear in response to a subpoend issued as provided in this section shall be
2 1	punished as provided by law.
