*A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-108 of the Code of Virginia, relating to receiving stolen goods.*

**Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

**1. That § 18.2-108 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

§ 18.2-108. Receiving, etc., stolen goods.

If any person ~~buy~~buys or ~~receiv~~receives from another person, or ~~aid~~aids in concealing, or sells to another person any stolen goods or other thing, knowing the same to have been stolen, he shall be ~~deemed~~ guilty of larceny thereof, and may be proceeded against, although the principal offender ~~be~~ has not been convicted.

**2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment in state correctional facilities. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation is \$0.00.**
