VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.1-548.9 and 2.1-548.12 of the Code of Virginia, relating to economic development services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia: 6

1. That §§ 2.1-548.9 and 2.1-548.12 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows: 7 8 § 2.1-548.9. Industrial Development Services.

9 It shall be the policy of the Commonwealth to encourage, stimulate and support the industrial development and the expansion of the economy of the Commonwealth. The Division of Industrial 10 Development of the Department is charged with the following duties and responsibilities: 11

1. To see that there is prepared and carried out an effective industrial promotional program;

2. To make available, in conjunction and cooperation with localities, chambers of commerce, 13 14 industrial authorities, and other public and private groups to prospective new industries basic information 15 and pertinent factors of interest and concern to such industries;

3. To formulate, promulgate and advance programs throughout the Commonwealth for encouraging 16 17 the location of new industries in the Commonwealth and expansion of existing industries;

4. To establish such offices within and without the Commonwealth that are necessary to the 18 19 expansion and development of industries and trade; and

20 5. To assist, solicit and encourage organizations involved in television broadcasts and motion pictures 21 to utilize the attractions and features of the Commonwealth. 22

§ 2.1-548.12. Tourism and travel services.

23 It shall be the policy of the Commonwealth to encourage, stimulate and support tourism and travel in 24 the Commonwealth. The Division of Tourism of the Department is charged with the following duties 25 and responsibilities: 26

1. To see that there is prepared and carried out an effective tourism and travel promotional program;

27 2. To make available, in conjunction and cooperation with localities, other public and private groups 28 engaged in similar or related work, basic information and pertinent factors of interest and concern to 29 tourists and the travel industry; and

30 3. To operate information centers and to establish such other offices within and without the 31 Commonwealth that are necessary to inform the public of places of interest within the Commonwealth 32 and provide such other information and services deemed necessary-; and

33 4. [Repealed.]

34 4. To assist, solicit and encourage organizations involved in television broadcasts and motion pictures to utilize the attractions and features of the Commonwealth. 35
