15	The Board of Education shall identify those provisions of the Standards of Accreditation providing
	flexible implementation alternatives to the several school divisions of the Commonwealth and shall

17	establish consistent criteria for granting applications for such flexibility. The Board shall inform the
	House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance of its findings by November
19	1, 1995.
